

Speech by Rosalia Alba Castiglione, Councilor for Property and Housing Policies – Rome City Council

In her speech, Rosalia Alba Castiglione, Councilor for Property and Housing Policies, pointed out the need to rebuild a design, a vision of the city. Rome must be a city of great opportunities, turning the return of interest of investors, including international investors, into a reality. Properties need to be obtained within the territory, the purchase of a house is a virtually impossible goal for broad sections of the population. We would like to introduce co-housing into our territory, as has already occurred in other European cities, because it can offer a modern and flexible solution, for example for out-of-town students and off-site personnel. But houses for families of a smaller size and more accessible cost than currently available are also needed. Rome's future lies in regeneration. I hope that today's event, promoted by Assoimmobiliare, represents the start of a partnership that will allow us to develop.
